



**Letter of recommendation to support publication of the book  
*Intuition – Theory and Practical Applications*  
in the English and French languages**

Regina Obermayr-Breitfuß, PhD, has been conducting researching on the subject of intuition since 1987. Her insights were presented in her doctoral thesis which was subsequently published as a book.

This publication contains a comprehensive overview of the subject of intuition. It goes beyond the common understanding of "passive" intuition and explains in a simple yet very descriptive manner how intuition can be used by anyone in an "active" way. Above and beyond this, the book is an ideal reference work on insights into quantum physics. In the early stage of her research, Dr. Obermayr-Breitfuss and her research on intuition were little noticed. Today, web search engines find 34,000 entries on "intuition training" alone. For example, Professor Peter Kruse, PhD, uses "collective intelligence" for his market analyses. Based on systematically arranged questionnaires which are designed to trigger "intelligent processes", he uses the intuition of his test subjects to evolve non-statistical models of prognosis. The examples given in the book awaken and encourage one's desire to develop one's own intuition.

Dr. Obermayr served as scientific director of a TV series on intuition which the science channel of the Bavarian Broadcasting Corporation (BR-Alpha) has produced and will broadcast in 13 episodes in the fall of 2009. Since 2001 she has also taught intuition at a private university in Vienna and is renowned as the leading expert in her field in the German-speaking world.

Her book, which clearly defines and illustrates intuition, has become an essential part of the standard literature. Taking into account the importance of the work, there are now plans to translate it into the English and French languages. Unfortunately Dr. Obermayr-Breitfuss has not received public funding for this project, which is why she is asking for financial support.

Dr. Obermayr-Breitfuss is a corresponding member of our society. Thanks to her practical approach, her speeches have not only convinced many participants in our events about the importance of intuition but have evoked great enthusiasm.

We support her initiative and are looking forward to her success in making this important work known outside of the German-speaking world.
